

• Mgt Int: BOB

Bank hope to have our ATMs recalibrated by Nov 24-25: BoB

>>Regarding an impact on credit growth, there could be some change, but it is too early to take a call. "But doomsday should be avoided. Even if there is negative outcome, Mgt is hoping the corrections would happen."

>>Slippages declined this quarter for the bank, and the guidance of Rs 45,000-50,000 crore of GNPA by FY17 remains the same.

• Mgt Int: HPCL

Catching up with private players will take some time: HPCL chief

>>HPCL witnessed an inventory loss of of USD 1 per barrel.

>>On growing competition, Mgt said that there is space for everybody because the whole Indian market is growing at a good rate

>>If the current growth rate in the Motor Spirit (MS) market it is around double digits and in diesel it is also around 6 percent.

>>Marketing margins will be maintained at last year's level.

Realty prices will correct due to demonetisation: Can Fin Homes >>Along with Seventh Pay Commission, good monsoon and everything else as positive, demonetisation will have a positive impact as far as the real home buyers are concerned.

• Mgt Int : HDFC

Demonetisation: To widen tax base, push interest rates lower, says Deepak Parekh

>>According to Mgt, there is all likelihood of land prices going down, secondary real estate sale prices falling and one can see a decrease in loan against property.

>>However, on the positive side, since the government is keen to kickstart the economy again, interest rates could come down to the tune of 0.5-1 percent next year, real estate prices will be more in white and builders may have to bring down prices to increase liquidity.

• Ramco Systems inks pact with Melbourne firm . RAMCOSYS has inked a deal with a Melbourne-based logistic service provider SeaRoad Holdings for its Ramco Logistics Suite.

• **BPCL** is expected to expand the capacity of its Kochi refinery in southern India to 310,000 barrels per day from the current 190,000 bpd in the next fiscal year. The company's naphtha exports have reduced over the past two years as it maximised its yield to produce more gasoline to meet domestic demand and as it processed heavier crude grades

>>Expect Trump to be pro-business, pro-capitalism, pro-American government but that does not mean they will be antiglobalisation or anti-Indian IT.

>>3QFY17 could see seasonal impact in retail manufacturing but good numbers will follow if they keep transforming client relations

>>Software and software-driven automation remains the key to future

>>Mgt is confident of achieving target set for the year 2020 of USD 20 billion.

- Australian unemployment rate remained unchanged at a seasonally adjusted 5.6%, from 5.6% in the preceding month. Analysts had expected Australian unemployment rate to remain unchanged at 5.6% last month.
- U.S. Crude Oil Inventories rose to a seasonally adjusted annual rate of 5.274M, from 2.432M in the preceding month. Analysts had expected U.S. Crude Oil Inventories to rise 1.480M last month.
- U.S. industrial production remained unchanged at 0.0%, from -0.2% in the preceding month whose figure was revised down from 0.1%.
- Japan's industrial production rose to a seasonally adjusted 0.6%, from 0.6% in the preceding month. Analysts had expected industrial production to remain unchanged at 0.0% last month
- Chinese Retail Sales fell to an annual rate of 10.0%, from 10.7% in the preceding month. Analysts had expected Chinese Retail Sales to remain unchanged at 10.7% last month.
