

Top News

- **Kitex Mgt Guideline :** The Cabinet on Wednesday released various incentives for the textile industry to boost growth, especially in exports and employment segments. The industry continues to face stiff competition from countries like Bangladesh and Vietnam. The incentives released will help aid profitability more than income . Government support will make investors more confident. State levy remission will help save funds . The company's capex plans are for doubling capacity in the next three years. The target is to achieve revenue growth of more than 20 percent in FY17
- Infosys founder Narayana Murthy's investment company Catamaran Capital has bought 0.77 percent equity in amusement park operator Wonderla taking its shareholding in the amusement park operator to about 1-1.5 percent . Both the companies are in talks and Wonderla is open for more such deals . The company operates amusement parks in Bengaluru, Hyderabad and Kochi and is targeting expanding in 4-5 new markets in the next few years . The company hopes to clock a 20-25 percent topline growth in FY17 . Chittilappilly said that while Bengaluru and Hyderabad operations are doing well in terms of revenue and footfall, Kochi saw a 7-8 percent drop in footfall owing to factors like service tax that came in last year . Company however, said business from the other two centres would offset the footfall drop in Kochi and it won't give a revenue guidance for FY17.
- Man Infraconstruction is aiming to increase saleable area on the back of new policy changes . Not just this, Company further expects the company to double revenues in FY17. Company said the promoter's stake is likely to increase in Man Infra going forward. The current promoter's stake stands at 61.5 percent in the company, of which Radhakrishna Damani and family owns approximately 2 percent (around 45 lakh shares) in company. - **Tata Communications** is going to sell its subsidiary company Neotel. Liquid Telecom and Royal Bafokeng Holdings (RBH) have entered into an agreement to acquire Neotel for ZAR 6.55 billion (Rs 2900 crore).

- A2Z Infra Engineering has received a contract from ministry of energy and mineral development (The Republic of Uganda) for design, supply and construction of MV lines and associated low voltage network in various project areas along Kawanda Masaka 220KV transmission line of USD 3.8 million.
- UPL Ltd has informed that Hon'ble High Court of Gujarat at Ahmedabad has approved the Scheme of Amalgamation of Advanta and UPL and their respective Shareholders and Creditors . The Scheme will come into effect upon filling certified true copy of order with the Registrar of Companies at

- U.S Gross domestic product increased at a 1.1 percent annual rate, rather than the 0.8 percent pace reported last month . First-quarter GDP growth has now be revised higher by sixtenths of a point since the advance estimate was published in April. The economy grew at a rate of 1.4 percent in the fourth quarter. Economists polled by Reuters had expected first-quarter GDP growth would be revised up to a 1.0 percent
- U.K. CBI realized trades fell to 4, from 7 in the preceding month. Analysts had expected CBI realized trades to fall to -2 last month.
- Statistics Sweden said that Swedish Retail Sales rose to a seasonally adjusted 1.7%, from 0.2% in the preceding month. Analysts had expected Swedish Retail Sales to rise 0.8% last month.
- **German Import Price Index** rose to a seasonally adjusted 0.9%, from -0.1% in the preceding month. Analysts had expected German Import Price Index to rise to 0.6% in the last month.
